Dear Members of the Texas Legislature:

On behalf of the Fort Worth Chamber of Commerce and our 2,000 business members, I'm writing you today to express support for Texas Central Railway's proposed high-speed rail line from Dallas to Houston.

As you know, the state of Texas is attracting thousands of new residents every day and those new Texans do not bring roads with them.
